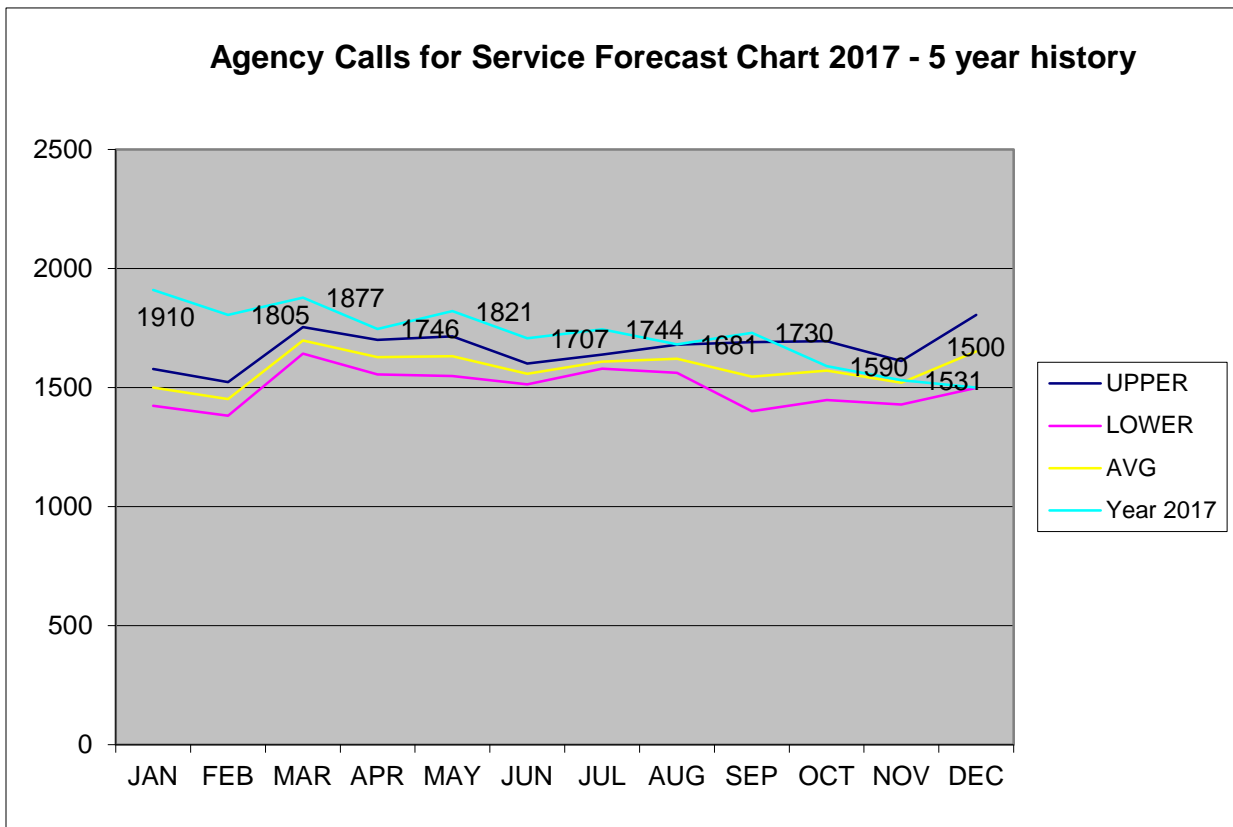

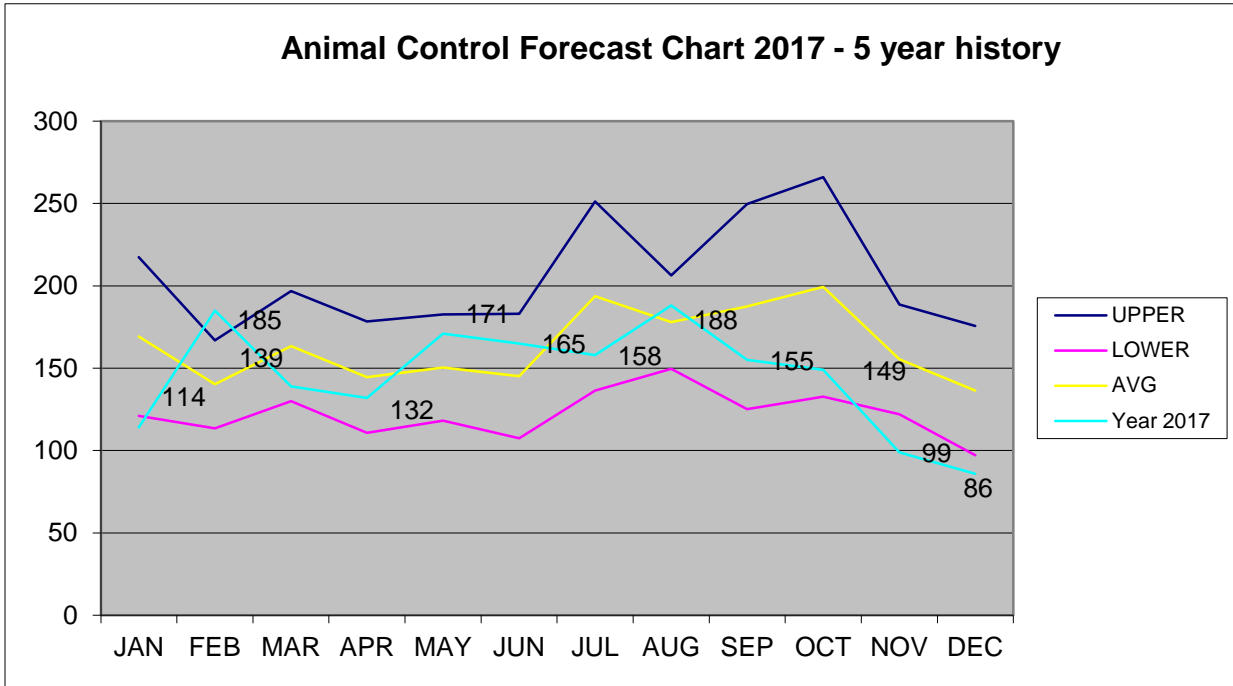
2017 Year End Report

The SPD maintains forecasting charts related to a number of activities performed by the PD. For example, the chart below shows a statistical picture of how many calls for service the department received from a 5 year perspective. Essentially, the dark blue line shows the highest number of recorded calls for service by month for the last 5 year period. As well, the teal color at the bottom shows the lowest number of calls by month recorded for the last 5 years. The yellow line forecasts where the agency can predict we should be for the preceding months. The light turquoise line at the top shows actual calls for service in 2017. So, what you should be able to see visually is that the agency has received an all-time high in calls for service in every month this year except for August, and October thru December.

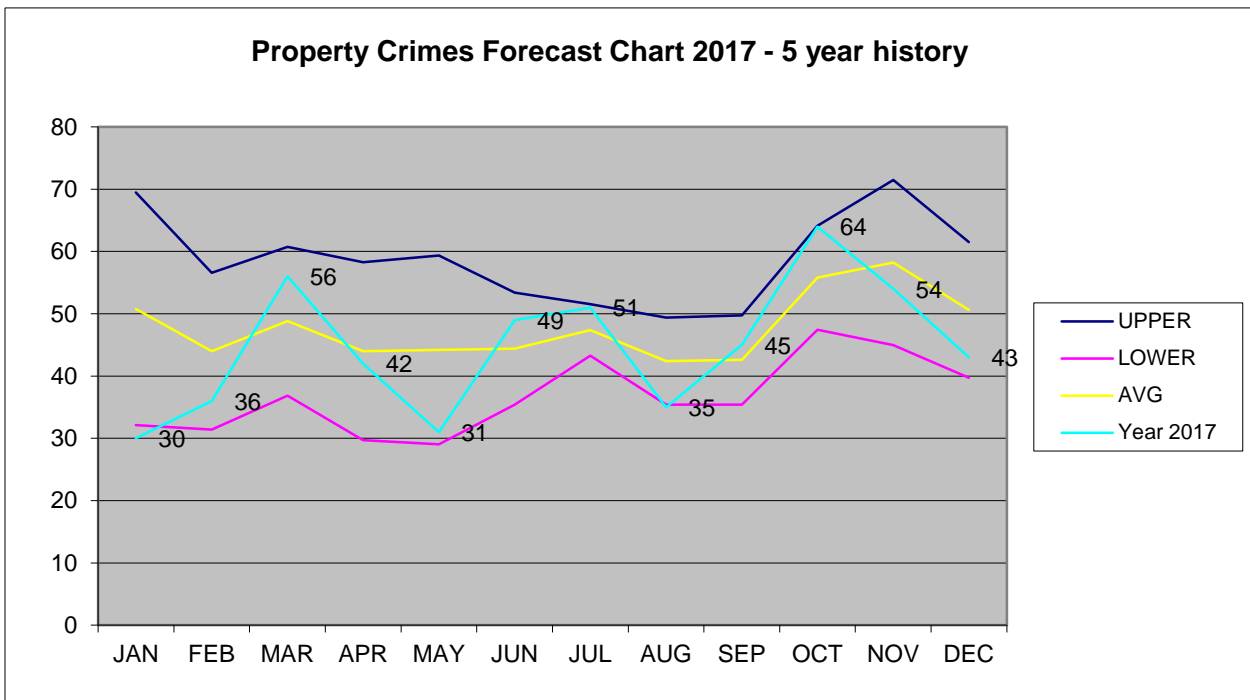

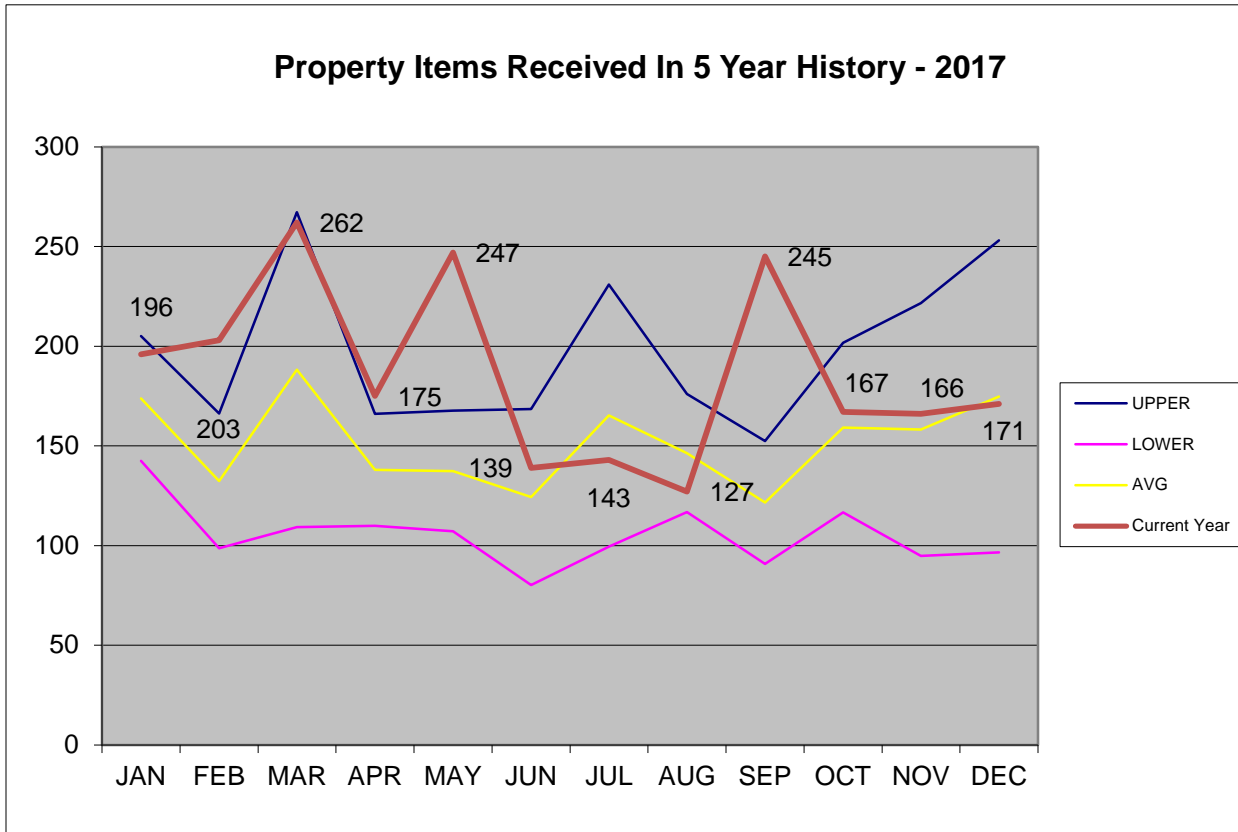
The same forecasting chart is prepared for Animal Control operations. As with the prior chart, you can see a bit better that the animal handling activities have generally stayed within our 5 year history except in February and latter months.



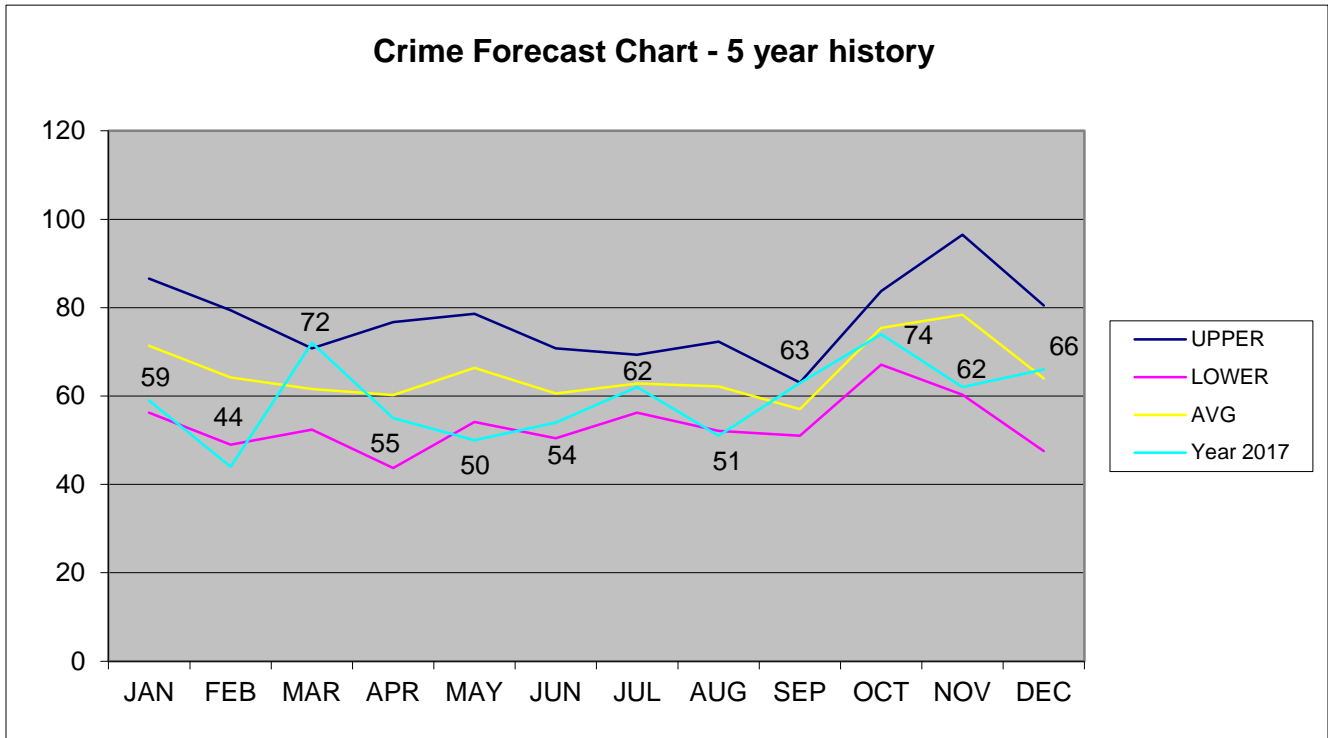
Property crimes are tracked also which covers burglaries, larcenies and vandalisms.



The Police Department also tracks the number of property items taken into the Property room. The chart below shows the 5 year history. During the 3rd Quarter of 2017, the Property room processed over 500 items of property.



The forecasting chart shows our overall crime history taking into account all crimes required to be reported to the Department of Justice via the Uniform Crime Reporting process. It should be obvious that the UCR crimes appear fairly consistent within the five year data collection.

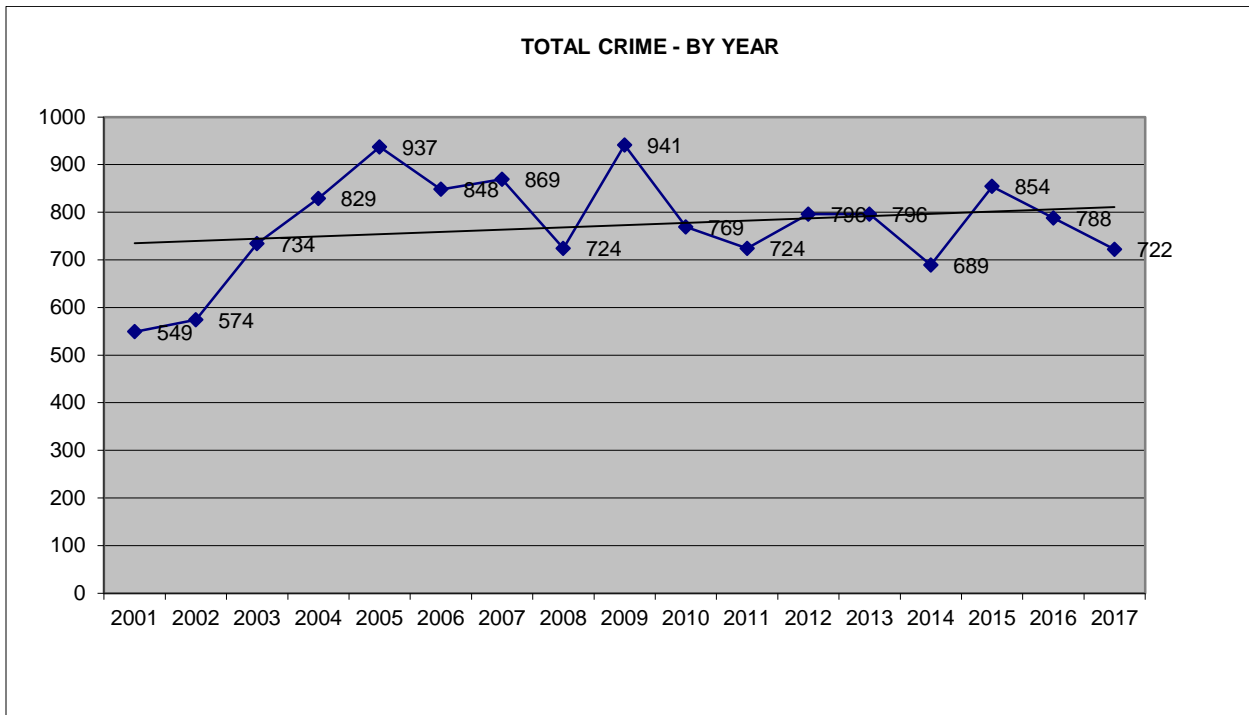

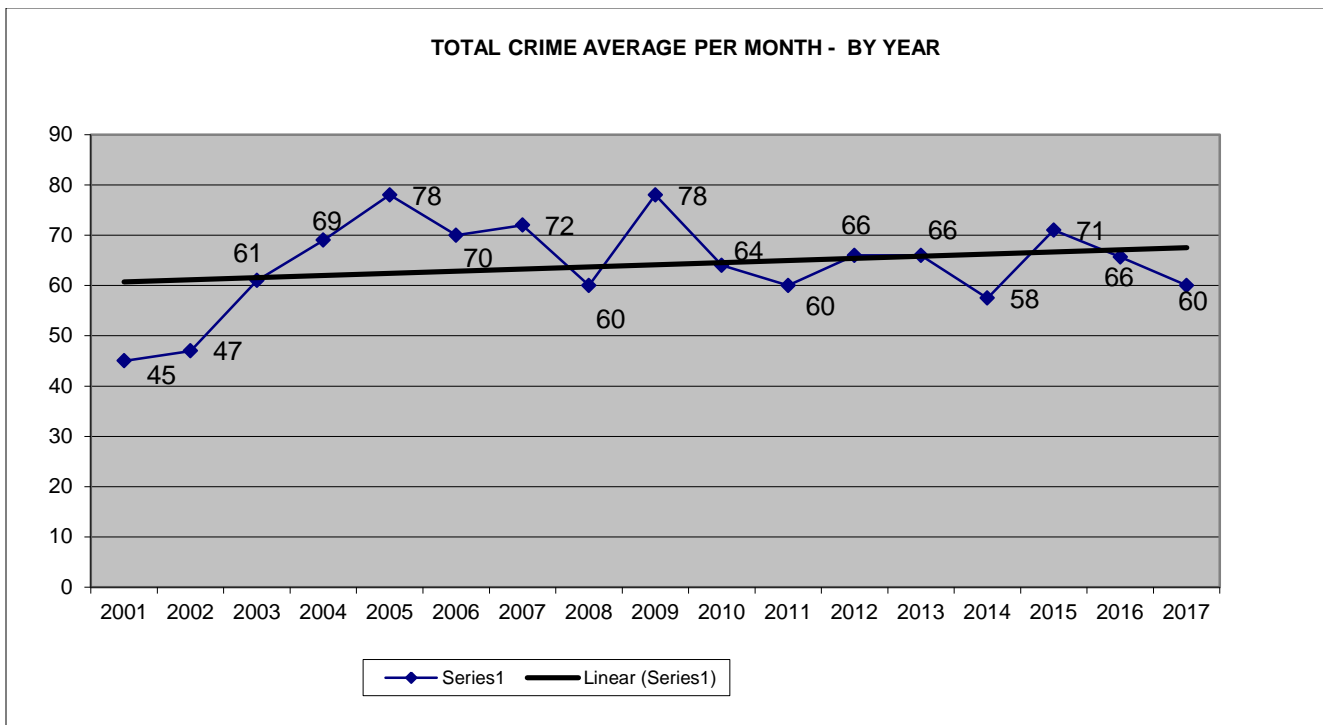

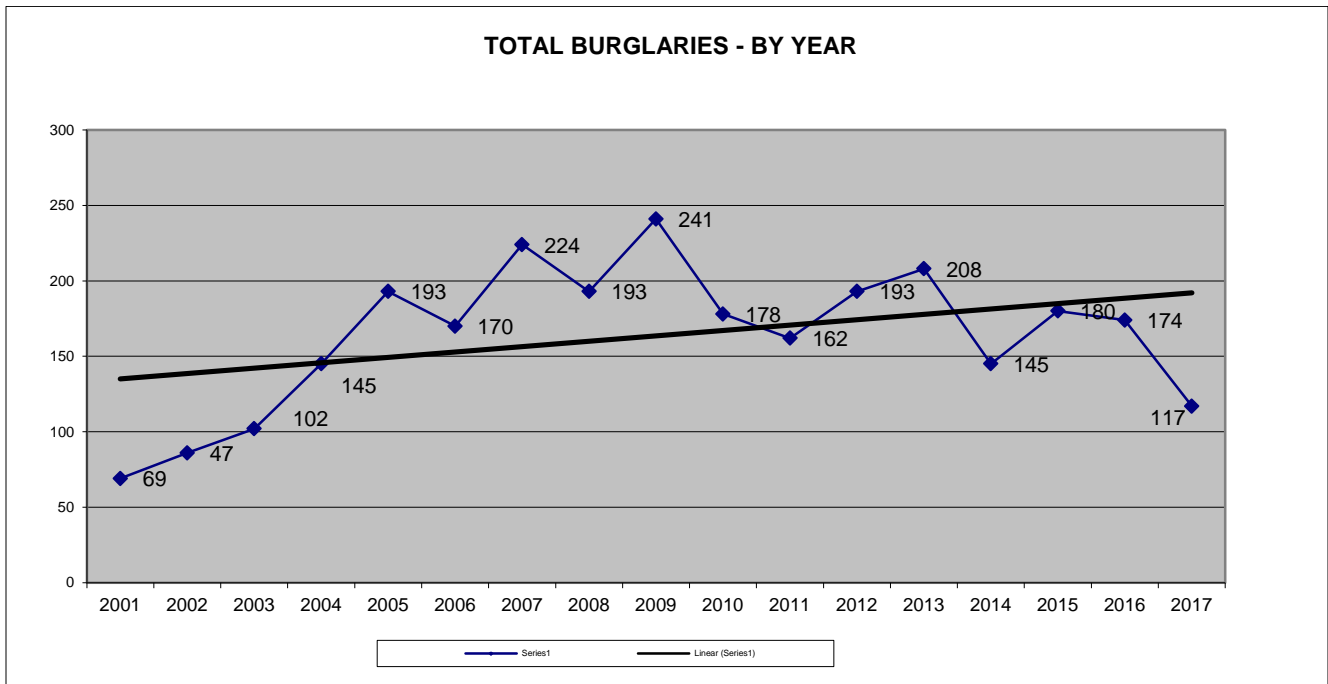
In order to provide a longer overview of crime in Shafter, the agency has kept statistics for total crimes by year starting in 2001. Statistics for 2017 are included below:



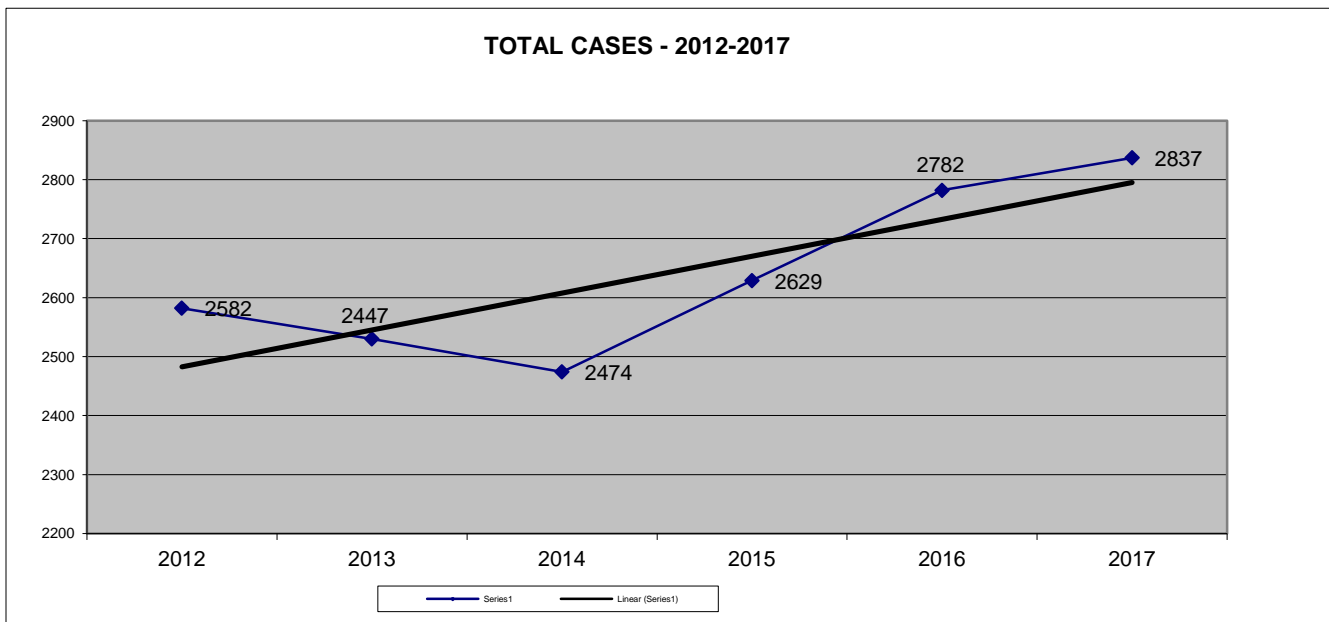
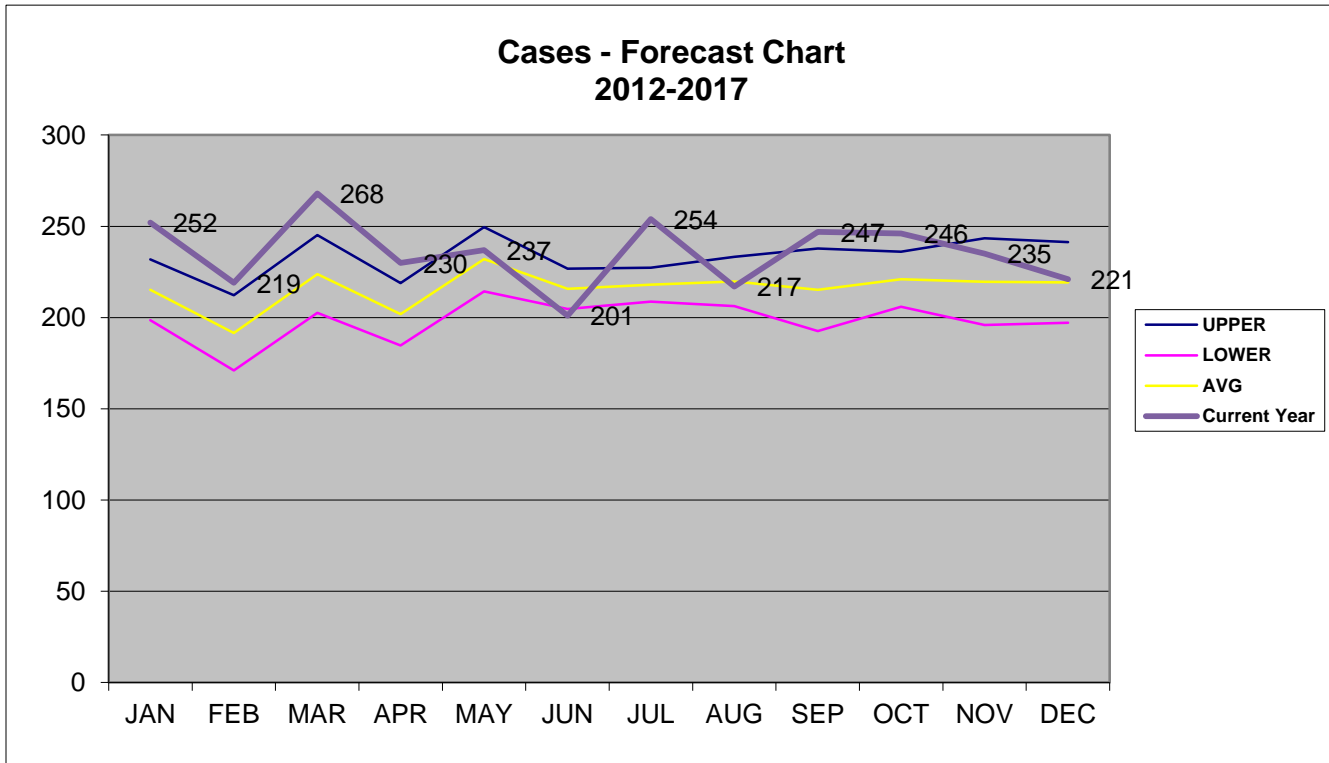
The chart below shows total crime averages by month – by year. As a reminder, our crime forecast chart only compares from the last 5 years.



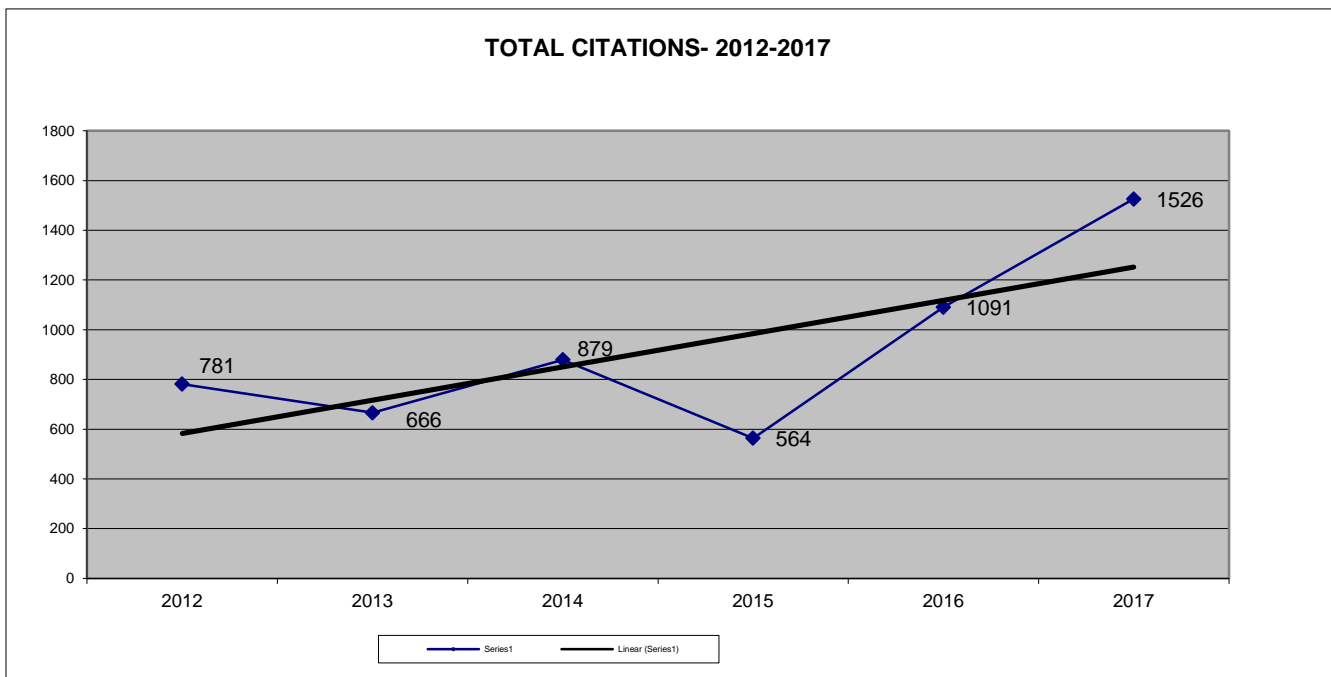
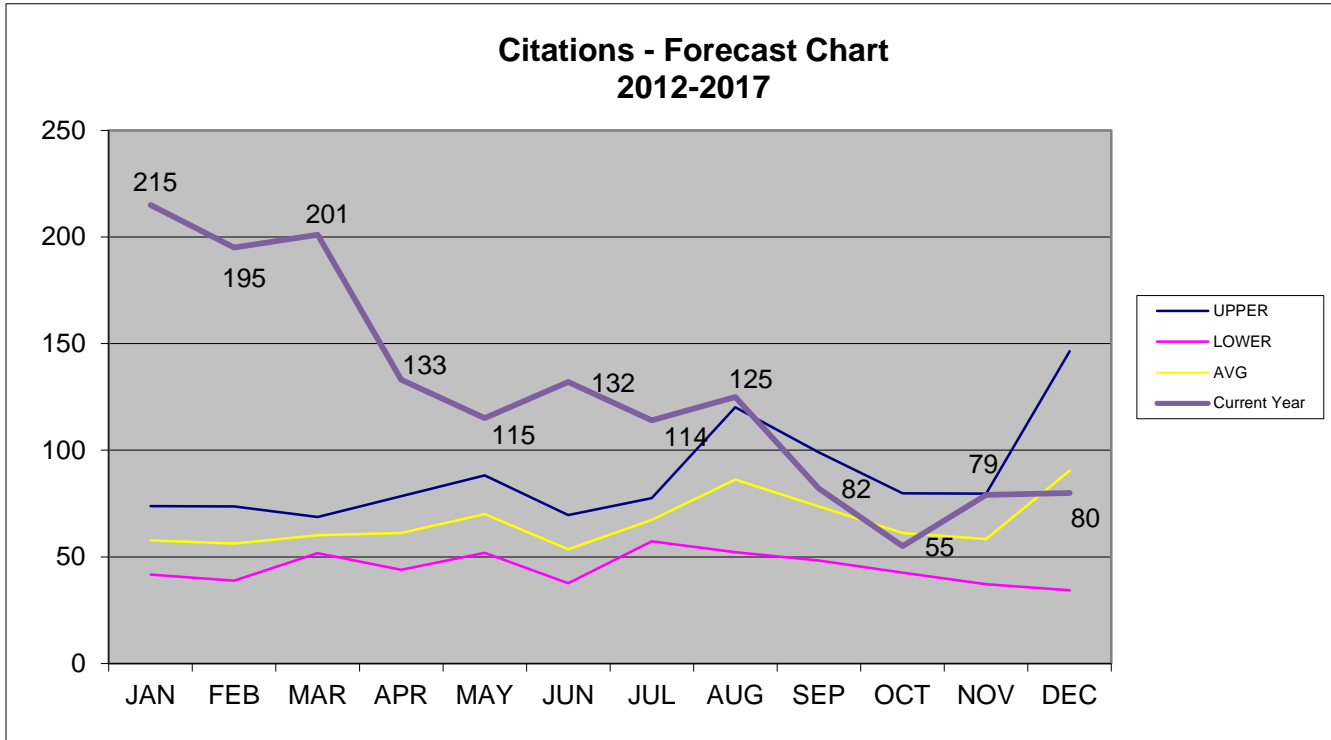
The Department additionally collects information on specific type crimes such as the chart below shows overall burglaries in the City by year.



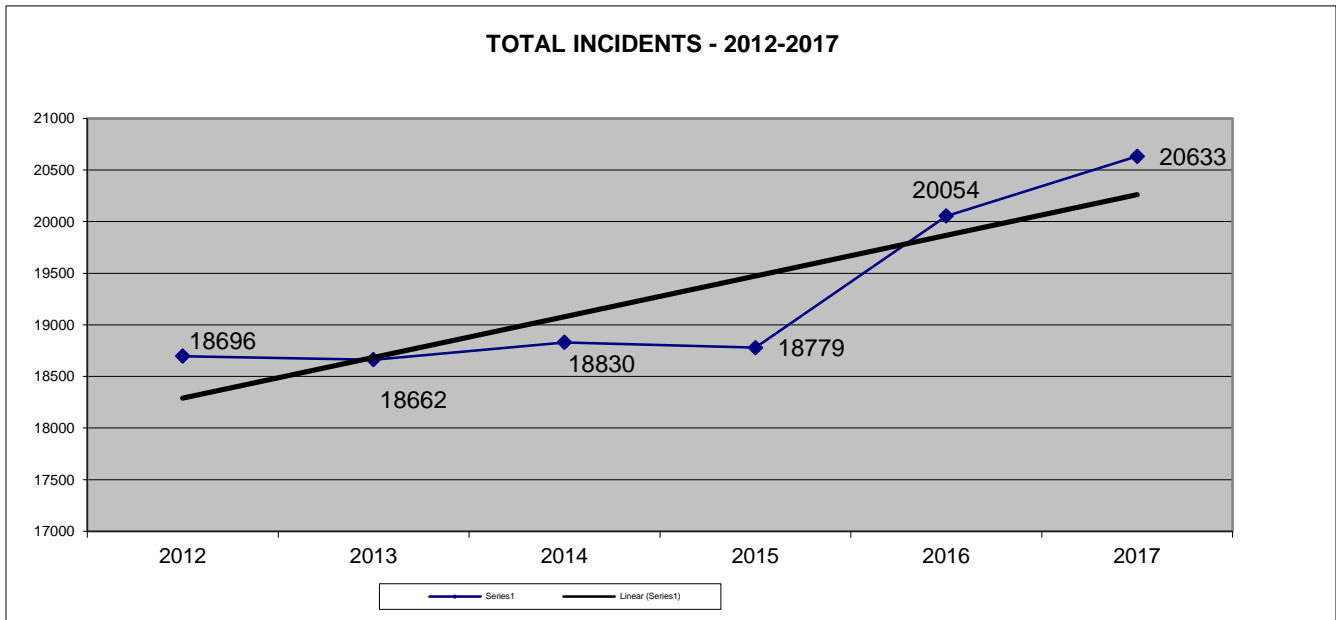
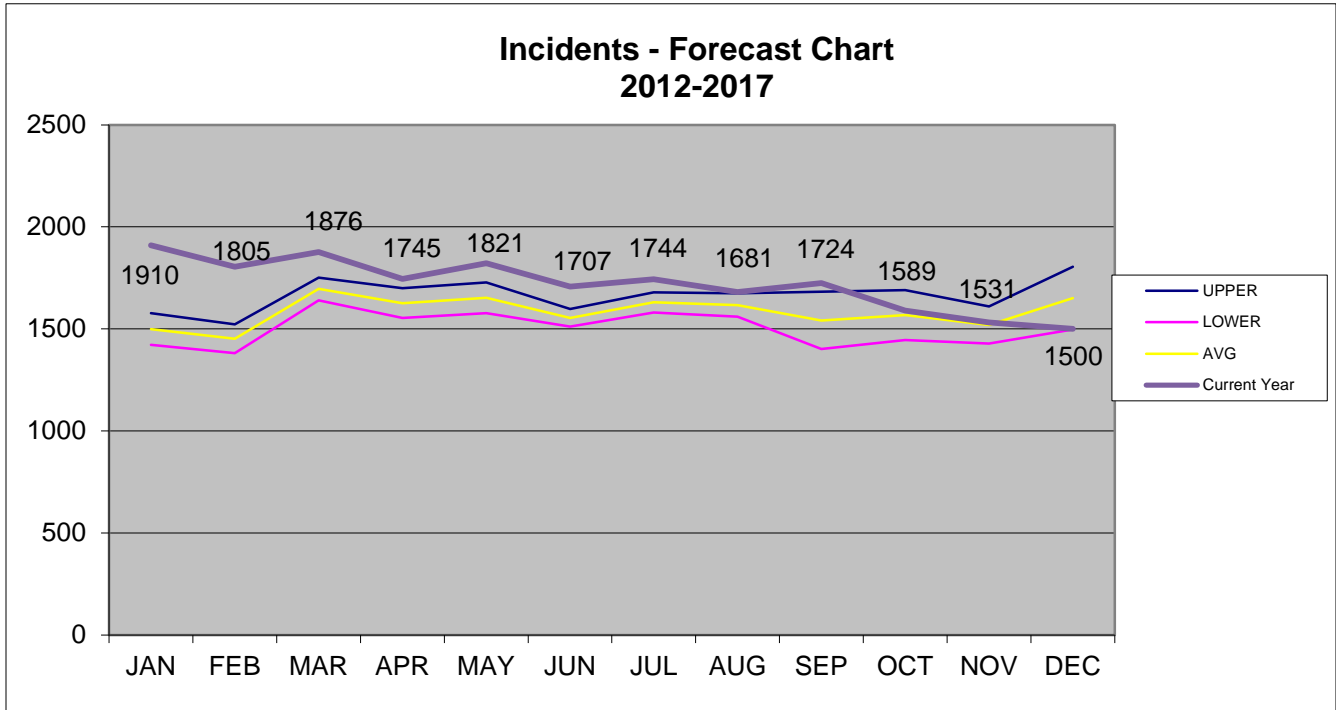

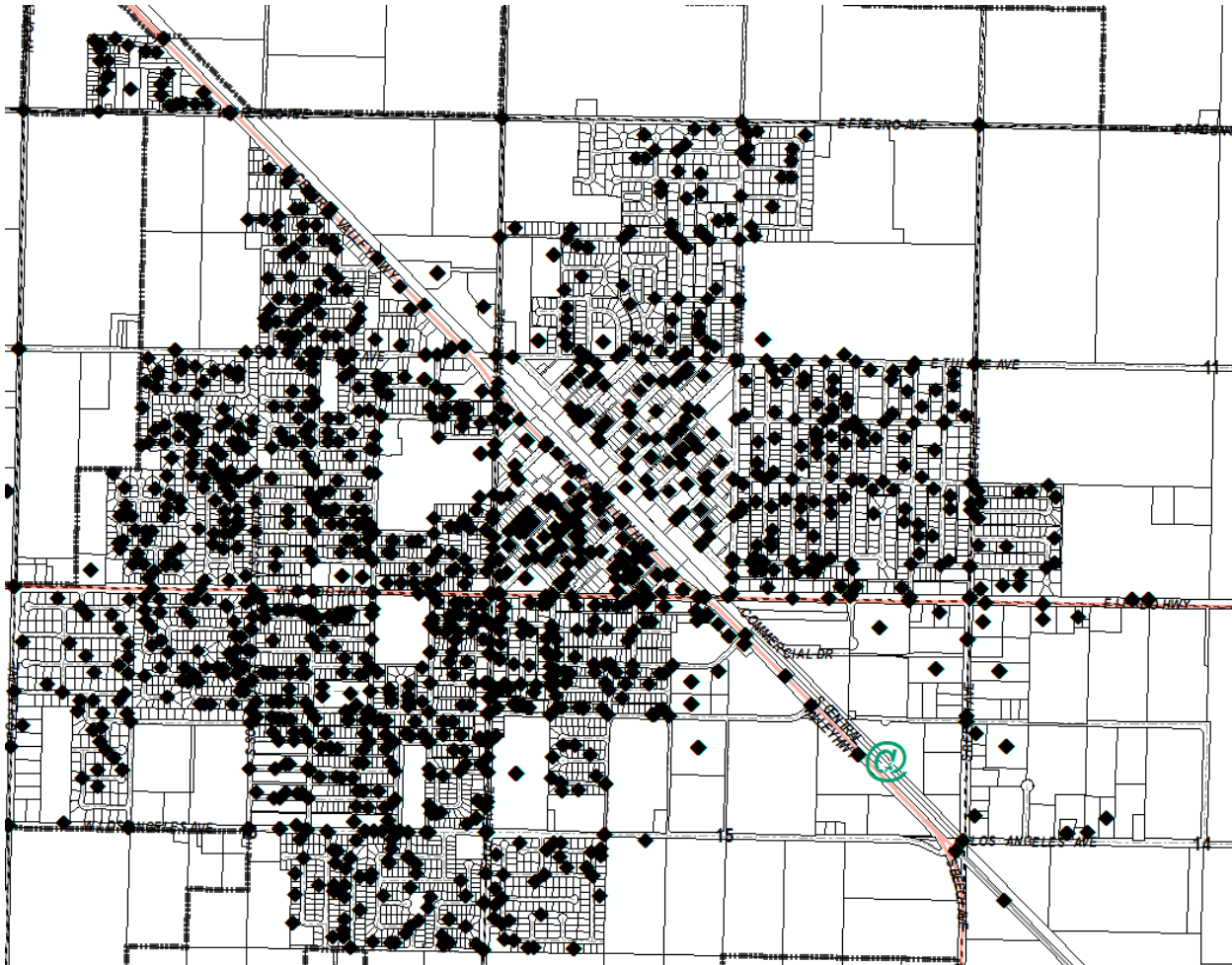
Like the previous page, the chart below shows the number of citations issued by month for 2017 as it compares to the last 5 years. The chart below that shows the year's total citations by year.



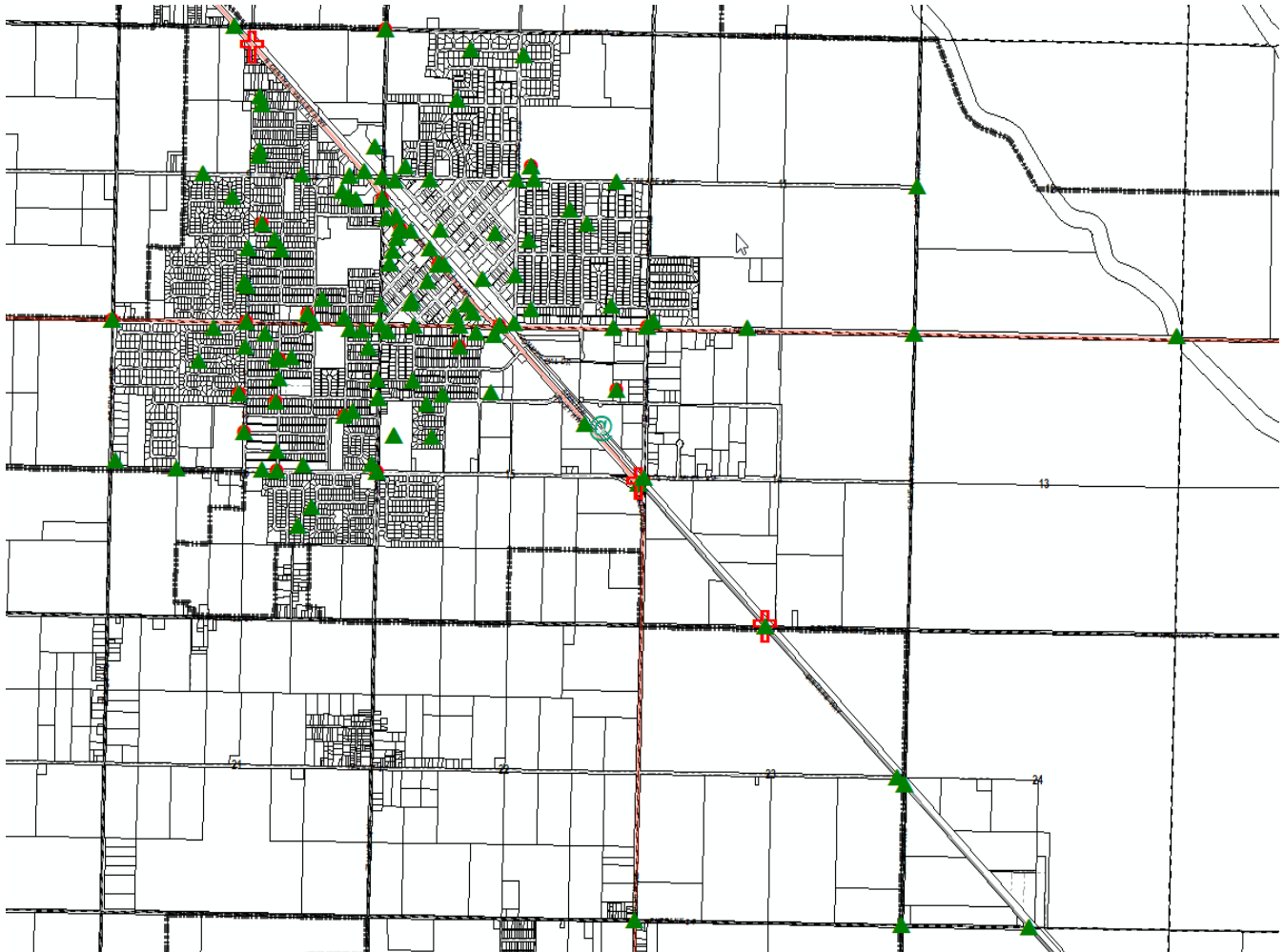
Final comparison charts. The chart below shows the number of incidents by month for 2017 as it compares to the last 5 years. The chart below that shows the year's total incidents by year.



The Records Incident Management System (RIMS) captures mapping, but is difficult to disseminate through a paper process. However, in 2017 Shafter Police Department processed or responded to 20,633 incidents. The map screenshot below shows incidents in the primary core of the city. It does not include all of the city boundaries.

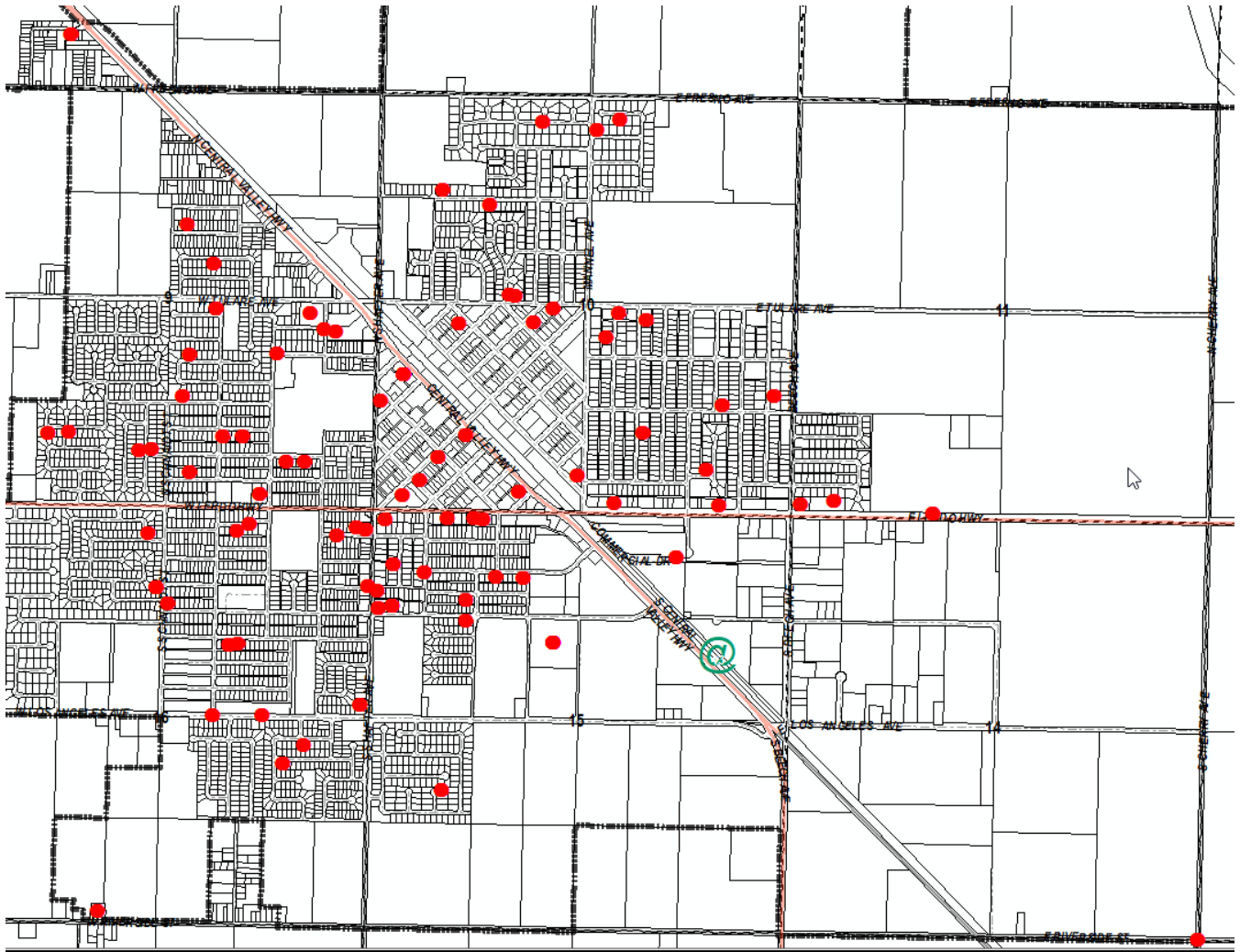


During 2017, Shafter PD responded to 246 traffic accidents with four fatalities. The below graphic is a core map showing location of these incidents.

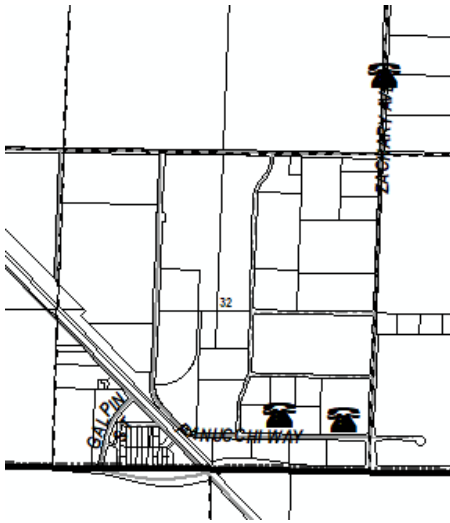

RIMS can do additional mapping options depending on the requests. Here is a map of burglary locations in the core of the city. There were a total of 114 reported burglaries for all of 2017. To show all burglaries the map would be too small for a handout. There were no reported burglaries for the Gossamer Grove area, but there were three in the Trade Zone area shown at the bottom.

We had 244 larceny cases in 2017. 92 occurred at Fastrip, 41 at Dollar General, 28 at Rite Aid, and 15 at Apple Market. The remaining offenses occurred at other locations in Shafter.
